This year's KYLF delegation will elect representatives from the four extension program areas (NE, NW, SE, SW) for one year terms on council. Up to 6 National Conference Delegates will be selected through an interview prior to KYLF and they serve a two year term on council.

Riley County Fair Beef Exhibitors

The Riley County Fair Board voted on Tuesday evening (September 26) to eliminate the market beef breed classes at the Riley County Fair. **We will return to breaking classes by weight and not by breeds**. The rationale is simple – our show isn't large enough to generate enough entries to make the breed classes work.

We are sending this message now so you can plan accordingly when shopping for a steer or market heifer this fall.

Note – swine will still have breed classes in the market hog show. Numbers are high enough that breed classes still work for swine.
