Responsibilities:

Work as a team with all Ambassadors, Advisors and 4-H Agent.

Attend all scheduled meetings and activities.

Deliver presentations and programs promoting 4-H to community groups.

Write material for radio and print media regarding 4-H promotion.

Recruit other teens to serve in the 4-H Ambassador role.

Serve as an Ambassador for one two-year term.

Attend annual Ambassador Training workshop.

Skills Needed:

Knowledge of Kansas and Riley County 4-H programs.

Willingness to meet people and promote new ideas.

Enthusiasm for the 4-H program.

Positive role model of 4-H to youth and adults.

Ability to manage his/her personal schedule.

Strong communication skills and ability to work well with diverse groups of people.

Time Required:

A 4-H Ambassador position is held for a two-year term. This position, on average, requires 5-10 hours per month.
