This is open to all 4-Hers meeting the criteria and no limit as to how many applicants a club may have. Clubs may nominate candidates and /or 4-Hers may complete an application on their own without being nominated by a club. The time line is as follows:

The candidates will be interviewed by the committee on May 22, 2019.

The Riley County 4-H Fair Royalty will be selected by an interview committee including a former king, former community club leader, and a person from the community that works in public relations.

The candidates will **not** visit the club meetings and there will be **no** vote at the 4-H Council meeting by council representatives.

After the Riley County Fair the Fair Royalty will have further responsibilities as listed on the responsibility page.

Please promote this among your 4-Hers 15 years and older. It is great leadership experience for them and will help them become outstanding leaders for the 4-H program and the Riley County Fair.

All candidates are eligible to apply for a \$1000 leadership scholarship from the Riley County Foundation.
