

KISER LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

All eligibility requirements must be met to be considered:

- ▶ Enrolled in the Riley County 4-H Program for a minimum of 5 years.
- ▶ GPA of 3.0 in high school and/or college prior to application and minimum of 2.0 after first semester.
- ▶ May be used at any 2 year accredited community college or 4 year accredited college in the United States.
- ▶ Application must be completed and submitted with one letter of recommendation from a 4-H Club Leader and high school transcript.

The following requirements should be addressed in item #5 of the application.

- ▶ Enrolled in the leadership project for a minimum of 3 years.
- ▶ Leadership in the Riley County program in a minimum of 2 of the following:
 - *4-H Council—office or committee chair
 - *Ambassadors
 - *Fair Events—Superintendent/Junior Superintendent
 - *Camp Counselor
 - *Citizenship Washington Focus committee chair
 - *Serve as the 4-H PDC youth representative
 - *Served as coach or director for Club Day/Gavel Games activity
- ▶ Leadership in local club (a minimum of 2)
 - *Club officer (1 or 2 different offices)
 - *Club project leader (1 or 2 different projects)
- ▶ Leadership by having been elected or a candidate for Fair Royalty of the Riley County Fair. Candidate must have been elected or candidate prior to applying for the scholarship.

Two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded in 2023.

The scholarship will not be renewable.

The person awarded the scholarship must show proof of enrollment in college.

An interview with the Riley County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Committee and two representatives of the Kiser family must be completed.

Kiser Leadership Scholarship

The following application is for the Kiser Leadership Scholarship. This scholarship will be given to a 4-H'er who has demonstrated outstanding involvement and leadership in the Riley County 4-H program. The scholarship may be used at any 2 year accredited community college or 4 year accredited college in the United States.

Any Riley County 4-H'er or former 4-H'er who was elected or a candidate for Riley County Fair King or Queen and who is completing their senior year of high school or in college may apply, providing they meet the criteria specified in the application. See attached requirement sheet.

Finalists will be selected and interviewed by the Riley County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Committee and 2 members of the Kiser family in the spring. The award will be announced and awarded upon proof of college enrollment.

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- 4-H Record of participation - 50% local
- Non-4-H Participation - 20%
- Interview - 20%
- G. P. A. - 10%

Please read instructions carefully.

Return your application to the **Riley County Extension Office**. Applications are due on **February 3**. Interviews will be scheduled for the finalists.

Each application must have these two items attached:

- * Transcript of high school grades plus most recent college semester grades if in college.
- * One letter of recommendation from a 4-H Club Leader
